




Grants from DAFs*


Grants from Supporting Organizations

MAKING SENSE

Column: The charitable funds that benefit rich donors and the financial industry

"Donor-advised funds" give donors all of the tax benefits of charitable giving, but impose no obligation that the money be put to active charitable use.

The main beneficiaries of commercial DAFs are the financial industry and its wealthy clientele.

Donor Advised Fund: A Relationship







Donor Advised Fund Technical Definition

- a fund (or account);
- separately identified by reference to contributions of a donor or donors;
- owned and controlled by the sponsoring organization;
 and
- with respect to which a donor (or any person appointed by the donor) has, or reasonably expects to have, advisory privileges with respect to the distribution or investment of amounts held in the fund or account by reason of that person's status as a donor.

Supporting Organization







Supporting Organization Technical Points

- No donor control
- No compensation to "persons described"
- Must have board of directors with annual meetings


